

# Pictionary Question Sheet

BOOK

**Is it fun to do homework?**

**If you decide to play a video game instead of doing your homework, how can you tell your teacher the truth when she asks where it is?** (Tell her you don't have it because you played video games)

DOG

**Raise your hand if you have a pet at your house!**

**Let's say one of your chores is to feed the dog every day. If you don't feed the dog one day, is it ok to tell your mom that you did so you won't get in trouble?** (No) **What might happen if you don't tell the truth – could it be even worse?** (Yes)

COOKIE

**What is your favorite kind of cookie?**

**Your mom tells you not to eat any cookies before dinner. If you eat one cookie, what should you tell your mom when she asks?** (That you ate one) **What if she doesn't ask, should you still tell her the truth?** (Yes) **Not saying anything is one way of lying.**

PARENTS

**Have you ever said something that wasn't true to your parents?**

**When our parents can't believe the things we say, will that help them trust us when we want to do fun things?** (No, telling the truth now helps our parents to trust us later)

BED

**Do you ever have to make your bed or clean your room?**

**When your parents tell you to clean your room, can you play in your room for an hour and then tell them that you cleaned?** (No) **Why?** (Because you didn't clean anything)

MONEY

**What would you do if you found some money on the ground?**

**Telling someone you found it and trying to find its owner is a way of telling the truth.**

PENCIL

**Have you ever forgotten to bring a pencil to school?**

**You ask your friend to borrow a pencil because you forgot yours. How would you feel if your friend lied to you and said they didn't have an extra pencil when you KNOW they have 25 different pencils?** (Hurt your feelings, don't like being lied to, etc.)
