

God Speaks to Samuel 1 Samuel 3:1-21

A long time ago, people called their church the Temple. There was a boy named Samuel who lived at the Temple. He helped the priest who worked there. The priest's name was Eli.



One night, Eli had already gone to bed and Samuel was sleeping in the Temple. Soon, Samuel heard a voice! It said, "Samuel, Samuel!"

Samuel thought Eli was calling him, so he got up, ran to Eli's room, and said, "Here I am, Eli!" But it wasn't Eli who called Samuel.



Samuel went back to sleep and the voice called to him again. Thinking that it was Eli calling, Samuel ran to Eli's room. But Eli hadn't called Samuel.
