







BIBLE STORY SHEET

Wk 2 - K-5 - Bible Story Sheet

READ and FOLLOW the instructions below, drawing on the dry erase board when prompted and allowing kids to guess what you may be drawing as you draw.

SAY: *I'm going to draw a picture on the dry erase board and you get to guess what I'm drawing. Then I will tell you what that picture means in our Bible story!*

<p>DRAW an <u>ear</u>:</p> 	<p>Then SAY: <i>Our lives are filled with so much noise, from the voices of the people we love to the sweet sounds of the great outdoors. But when we take time to get quiet enough to listen and spend some time with God, our friendship with Him will grow! That's why I drew an ear. Now let's see if you can guess what I'm going to draw next.</i></p>
<p>DRAW a <u>family</u>:</p> 	<p>Then SAY: <i>It's a family! That's because one time, when Jesus was a kid, His family went to the city of Jerusalem for a celebration. But on their way home, they couldn't find Jesus anywhere. So they rushed back and searched all over the city. When they found Him, Jesus was in the temple courtyard, quietly sitting and listening to the teachers there talk about God. He even asked questions, and everyone was amazed at how much He understood. Let's see if you can guess what I'm drawing now.</i></p>
<p>DRAW a <u>clock</u>:</p> 	<p>Then SAY: <i>Throughout Jesus' life, He was super busy, but He knew it was important to get quiet and spend time with God. That's why I drew a clock! You see, Jesus traveled all around telling people about God's love, and He loved helping people along the way. But Jesus also knew that it was very important to set aside time to get quiet and grow His friendship with God. Let's see if you can guess the next picture!</i></p>
<p>DRAW a <u>flower</u>:</p> 	<p>Then SAY: <i>It's a flower! In the book of Matthew we see how Jesus spent time with God in the great outdoors. Jesus knew the time was coming for Him to do something that only He could do, so He went to the garden of Gethsemane to spend time with God. The next picture will show us what happened after that. Can you guess what it is? (Allow responses)</i></p>
<p>DRAW a <u>cross</u>:</p> 	<p>Then SAY: <i>It's a cross! While Jesus was in the garden, He talked to God about what He had to do next. Jesus was going to take the punishment for all of the wrong things we do by dying on the cross. He knew He had to do this to make a way for us to have a friendship with God. Jesus could have talked to His friends about how He was feeling, but instead, He knew that His heavenly Father was the best person for Him to talk to. Let's see if you can guess the next picture!</i></p>
<p>DRAW a <u>heart</u>:</p> 	<p>Then SAY: <i>I drew a heart because I want us to remember that when we get quiet and spend time with God, just like Jesus did, our friendship with God grows! We can know that God is listening when we talk, and if we make it a habit, we'll start to know what His heart and voice sounds like, too!</i></p>
