

Peppy Says Sheet

Let's do what Peppy Says to help us know how to be **KIND** with our words:



- ❄ **When your sister shares her snack with you, should you say, "Give me that," or, "Thank you"?** (Allow responses.)
- ❄ **Peppy Says, if you said, "Thank you," put your PENGUIN on your snowy paper.** (Kids will place a **Penguin Sticker** on **Winter Scene**.)



- ❄ **When I get hungry, I get really mad and say, "I want food NOW!" Peppy Says, if you think this is using KIND words show a thumbs up. But if this is using MEAN words, show a thumbs down.** (Allow kids to show thumbs down.)
- ❄ **Right! If you can use KIND words like, "May I please have a snack?" Peppy Says put a snowflake on your snowy paper.** (Kids will place **Snowflake Sticker** on **Winter Scene**.)



- ❄ **If you want to play with your friend's toy car, should you JERK it away or should you ask, "Can I have a turn?"** (Allow responses.)
- ❄ **Peppy Says, if you said, "Can I have a turn?" you can put the mittens on your chilly willy penguin.** (Kids will place **Mitten Stickers** on **Penguin**.)



- ❄ **You hear a kid at church say, "I'm not your friend anymore," to another kid. Peppy Says, if you think those sound like MEAN words, raise both hands high in the sky.** (Kids will raise hands high in sky.)
- ❄ **If you can say KIND words to your friends, Peppy Says to put a snowflake on your snowy paper.** (Kids will place **Snowflake Sticker** on **Winter Scene**.)



- ❄ **Your dad just asked you to clean your room because it is bed time. Should you say, "No way," or should you say, "Yes sir"?** (Yes sir.)
- ❄ **Peppy Says if you said, "Yes sir," put a hat on your penguin.** (Kids will place **Hat Sticker** on **Penguin**.)



- ❄ **If your teacher asks you to stop throwing toys, should you throw a toy at her or should you say, "Yes ma'am," and stop throwing toys?** (Allow responses.)
- ❄ **Peppy Says, if you said, "Yes ma'am," and stopped throwing toys, put your shirt or scarf on your chilly penguin.** (Kids will place a **Shirt/Scarf Sticker** on **Penguin**.)
