Loving Words Guide



Your brother lost his mitten in the snow. You help him look for it and cheer when you find it under the pile of snowballs.

Did you love your brother with your words? (Yes)

When we love others with our words, we are loving God!



Your dad asked you to come inside and leave the snowman alone. You get mad at your dad and knock over the snowman. The next day he asks, "Who knocked over the snowman?"

Should you tell a LIE or tell the TRUTH? (Tell the truth)

When we tell the truth, we are loving God with our words!



If your neighbor says "don't climb my tree, please," and you say "yes ma'am" did you love God with your words? (Yes)

That's right! When we use kind words toward others it makes God so happy!

Can you love God with your words? (Yes)



If your mom tells you to put on your hat, should you say "no way" or "okay"? (Okay)

If we obey and use kind words, are we loving God? (Yes)

That's right! When we say KIND words to others we are showing God we love Him with our words!



Your sister threw a snowball at you and it hit you in the face. You are really mad! You yell at your sister and run away crying.

Did you use KIND words when you yelled at your sister? (No)

Even when it is hard. God wants us to love Him and others with our words!



Does God love you? (Yes) Do you love God? (Yes)

We can show God we love Him by using KIND words! That's what we Need to Know today! Say this after me: (pause to allow kids to repeat)

I Can (thumbs to chest) Love God (point up) With My Words (cup hands around mouth)!



If you jerk the last lollipop from your brother and say "give me that", did you use KIND words? (No)

Should you say "I'm sorry" to your brother? (Yes)

Saying "I'm sorry" when you do something wrong is one way to love God with your words. We can show God we love Him by using KIND words! That's what we Need to Know today! Say this after me: (pause to allow kids to repeat)

I Can (thumbs to chest) Love God (point up) With My Words (cup hands around mouth)!
