

SAY one of the following each time a team guesses who is “it” on the other team:

1. *When we read 1 John 4:16 in the Bible, it says, “God is love.” What does this verse tell us about God? (God is love) That’s right! God doesn’t just show love, He is love!*
2. *The very first verse in the Bible says that “In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.” So who does this verse say that God is? (Creator) Yes! God created everything, including you and me!*
3. *Jesus said, “Look at the birds in the air. They don’t plant... or store food in barns. But your Heavenly Father feeds the birds. And you know that you are worth much more than the birds.” What does this verse show us? (God is our Father and Provider) Yes! God loves you and gives you everything you need!*
4. *We can read in a book of the Bible called Numbers that “God is not a human being, and He will not lie.” So what does that tell us about God? (He’s different from us, He never lies) When God says something, you can count on it!*
5. *Psalm 18:32 says, “God is the one who gives me strength.” What does God want you to know from this verse? (He can give you strength) That’s right! God is always there to help us and give us strength when we need it!*
6. *Psalm 68:20 tells us that “Our God is a God who saves us... from death.” Is God the only one who can save us? (Yes) Yes, God is the only one who can save us. He sent Jesus to take the punishment for our sins so that when our bodies die on Earth, we can live forever with Him in heaven!*
7. *A man named Micah wrote a prayer to God that said, “Who is a God like you? You forgive your people when they do what is wrong... You enjoy being kind.” What was God trying to tell us through Micah’s words? (That He is forgiving and kind, there’s no one like Him) That’s right! God is so good to us!*
8. *God told Moses a lot of things about who He is. I’m going to read a verse from the book of Exodus in the Bible, and I want you to tell me two things you hear about who God is. So listen carefully! “I am a God who is tender and kind... I am slow to get angry. I am faithful and full of love.” (ALLOW the team to tell you two things about who God is from that verse; tender, kind, slow to anger, faithful, full of love)*
9. *In a book of the Bible called Deuteronomy we can read that, “The Lord your God is the one who goes with you.” How can knowing what God says in that verse help you every day? (Helps you not feel lonely, reminds you that you have someone who loves you with you at all times)*
10. *We’re memorizing a verse from Hebrews 11:6, and it says, “But without faith, no one can please God. We must believe that God is real and that He rewards everyone who searches for Him.” So what does God want us to know when we read this verse? (We need to have faith, believe that He is real, know that He wants to reward us and will reward us when we search for Him) Yes! God is the one true God, and He is very real! And He wants to reward you for searching for Him!*
