




BAPTISM CLASS MARCH 19 | 11 AM | UPPER ROOM REGISTER ONLINE

MATTHEW

28:18–19

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, gave these parting words to His disciples as a charge and a command. It is as if He said, "I got the project started, now I am going to finish it through my Holy Spirit working in many of you!" God showed us the heavenly pattern in the life and ministry of Jesus Christ who taught us to pray "on earth as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:10). We live in a culture that insists there is no Creator and therefore, no direction we have been given. We can't live without direction because God made us to take the world somewhere. He put it into our hearts, so we can't turn it off.

As Christians, we are in such a privileged position in every generation. The Author of all creation and history has revealed Himself, His creation design, and His plan to us in His Word. We know how, where, and why it all started. We can have such optimism and confidence because we don't have to invent a design to things, make up a direction, or try to see and predict a picture of the future. We can enjoy the anticipation of it coming as God promised.

Since we know the future unfolds according to His perfect plan, we are passionate, optimistic, and vigorous in announcing His salvation to all His nations and nourishing thriving churches. Jesus gave us



a charge to baptize the nations and teach them to obey all He has commanded us—all of Christ for all nations. This coming year we will be rebooting our missions efforts, remobilizing teams to South Africa, strengthening our partnership with Josiah Venture in Ukraine, as well as partnering with a new church planting effort in Mexico.

It is also good for us to remember that "all nations" includes our own. As we look to be part of the Spirit's work beyond our borders, we dedicate ourselves to His work within our own. Only the movement of the Holy Spirit working at a heart level in America will turn us in a new direction. So, we pray for it, joyfully share our faith, and dedicate ourselves to worshiping and obeying Christ.

Our missions efforts here include the local partner organizations that are doing the Lord's work in specialized ways. Young Life in Burlington County concentrates its evangelistic efforts towards middle and high school students. Options for Women is working to save unborn lives by focusing on mothers considering abortion and sharing Christ's love with them. These are not all the places in which we are invested and involved, but it gives you examples of the work being done through the missions portion of our operating budget.

The High King of Heaven is unstoppably on the move. His Spirit animates us (His "people house") to express His leadership and vision the way the wife in Proverbs 31 elegantly executes the vision of her husband. One day, the knowledge of the glory of our Lord will cover the earth the way the waters cover the seas (Habakkuk 2:14). That will happen; are you eager for it?

Jesus Christ is King; Heaven is an absolute monarchy. God the Father chose and enthroned Him already, His Spirit is bringing many sons into glory, and of His Kingdom there will be no end (Luke 1:33). We have the privilege of offering people the terms of how to be at peace with Heaven's King. It's God's Good News—through our mouths—for all nations.

MISSIONS, upopales

MEXICO: LUIS & MARCIA COTO

Luis and Marcia Coto and their 25-year-old daughter, Valentina, are missionaries from Costa Rica. They planted two churches in Costa Rica in 2003 and 2011, from which they sent missionaries to Asia, Africa, and America. In 2015, they began their cross-cultural missionary work in Querétaro, Mexico, where they taught and trained the pastors of local churches and the leadership team of an orphanage. In 2020, Luis and Marcia moved to Mérida in the Yucatán state of Mexico, where they are working with a local church, Capilla Calvario.



Since 2003, we have been in the ministry of being and making disciples of Christ, obeying the command that Jesus left us in Matthew 28:19-20. For the last two years, we have been sharing how to be and make disciples of Jesus with a group of more than 30 young people and have been directly training 13 of them, teaching them how to exercise leadership and disciple the next generation. In the same way, we have been intentionally supporting students from a Christian middle and high school, challenging them and encouraging them to grow closer to Jesus.

We have also been working with the women's ministry of our local church, building them up and equipping them as they strengthen their relationship with Christ. According to the needs of the families here in Mexico, we have been intentionally investing in marriages, encouraging them to love Christ and build a marriage according to the Word of God.

In continuing to obey God, we now want to plant a church with sound doctrine to evangelize, edify believers, equip disciples, and send workers to continue with the beautiful calling and ministry of being and making disciples. Our goal is to reach the lost first and

then to strengthen their foundation in Christ so that they can be fully trained and prepared for every good work.

We have experienced and seen how the Holy Spirit has led and enabled us to share the gospel with passion, clarity, and courage. He has opened spaces and opportunities to share Christ with nonbelievers and believers. He has also opened up their hearts to desire a relationship with Jesus and to know Him more. With those whom we have shared the Word of God, we have seen the Holy Spirit convicting and challenging them to draw closer to Christ.

Please pray for guidance and the total directing of the Lord in our steps of faith. Pray also for a strategic space (house) to start planting the new church, for the provision and equipment to start up and maintain the house church (furniture, Bibles, sound equipment, technology, etc.). We are also asking God to provide intentional times to invest in new and future members of the church. Please pray that God keeps our family and marriage from the snares of the enemy during this project.

UKRAINE: BEN & KRISTY WILLIAMS

Ben and Kristy Williams have served in Lviv, Ukraine since January 2007. They lead a team of 23 missionaries from Ukraine, Czech, and the United States who are committed to training young leaders to make disciples through the local church. They believe that God wants to use the next generation to transform society for His glory in Ukraine.

Unfortunately, we are in the ninth month of a full-scale war. In spite of the terror, trauma, and pain experienced in this nation, we can report from the spiritual front lines of the battle that the Lord is on the move.

While our city experiences missile attacks, daily air raid sirens, and constant threats from the enemy, we consider it pure joy to be able to still live and minister in Ukraine. While their childhood is abnormal and filled with interruptions, our children, Marissa (12) and Dylan (11), love Ukraine and are doing considerably well. While the army is under great peril, we hear almost daily reports from Christian soldiers about miracles and the protection and guidance of the Holy Spirit in every battle. Ukrainian believers are filled with faith, hope, and love for the people around them and are incredibly active in ministries.


Through youth ministry training, our team is working with a hundred churches who have active youth ministries in the heart of war

times. We just released a new course in personal evangelism and recently trained and equipped 350 youth leaders to share Jesus with those around them. The Holy Spirit is drawing people of all ages to Himself. Most Ukrainians are very open to spiritual conversations, reading the Bible, and taking steps closer to Christ. Right now, our youth group is praying for the salvation of Roman, Dasha, Max, Sophia, Maria, Oksana, Volodya, Yulia, Bodya, and others who actively attend our youth group and volleyball outreach.

Please pray for the salvation of the above young people and that churches we train would use the evangelism course in bold ways. Please pray that the enemy would leave Ukraine and never return. Please pray for us to be able to powerfully minister through the winter while heat, water, gas, electricity, and internet outages are expected. Pray for our family to "make the most of every opportunity in these evil days" (Ephesians 5:16).


