A SEASON OF STRENGTH

A Letter from Pastor Seth

In my Bible reading plan right now, I am reading through the book of Judges, which includes the story of the life of Samson. Samson's story is a famous one, and many people who read it know that the persuasion of a woman in his life led him to reveal to her the source of his strength. Delilah's loyalties were with her people, not Samson. Her people wanted to know what made him strong so they could destroy him as the judge and leader of his nation. So, she kept asking him about the source of his strength in order to give her people the upper hand to defeat him. He kept deceiving her, and when he woke up the next morning, his strength remained. Eventually, he told her that his hair was the source of his strength, and she cut it. The next morning, he expected to be as strong as he was the night before, but he was not. It turns out his hair was not the actual source of his strength, but rather it was a symbol of his vow—his loyalty and commitment to God.

He had broken his faith with God, and that severed relationship also broke his strength. His hair pointed to a deeper reality.

I certainly hope that you have a Bible reading plan of your own, and if you don't, summer is a great time to start one. Nothing strengthens the spiritual life like the daily intake of God's Word made powerful by the special ministry of the Holy Spirit, Who takes the words off the page and imprints them into our affections. Just like Samson, the source of our strength comes from the closeness of our relationship with God. Our relationship to God is our core relationship. If it's strong, it overflows like a spring, filling the rest of our life with strength. This truth gets reaffirmed in Scripture when the Bible tells us that the joy of the Lord is our strength (Nehemiah 8:10). We understand that joy is a gift God bestows through the Holy Spirit to those who walk with Him. (Galatians 5:22).

One of my many hopes for our congregation this coming summer is that it will be a season of strength for us. I pray that God grants us an inner vitality so this strength will be one of joy from God to us. May our reverence for God, our love and loyalty to Christ Jesus, and our humble submission to His Holy Spirit lead to a robustness that enhances our mission, encourages eager evangelism, deepens our fellowship, and increases our yearning to know God through His Word. In this special summer edition, we invite you to explore the many opportunities within our congregation to seek the joy of the Lord as your strength.

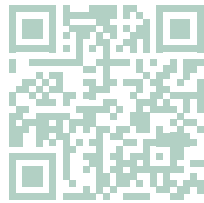
NEW TO FELLOWSHIP?

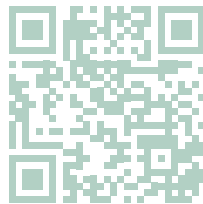

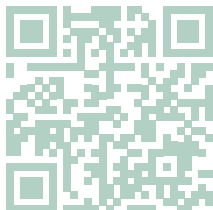

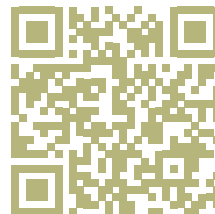
